L: For out of Zion shall go forth instruction, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.


C: He shall judge between the nations, and shall arbitrate for many peoples;

C: ... let us walk in the light of the Lord!









- 5 O come, O Key of David, come, and open wide our heav'nly home; make safe the way that leads on high, and close the path to misery. Refrain












# Affirmation of Faith

L: In the beginning was the Word,

C: ... and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

L: He was in the beginning with God.
